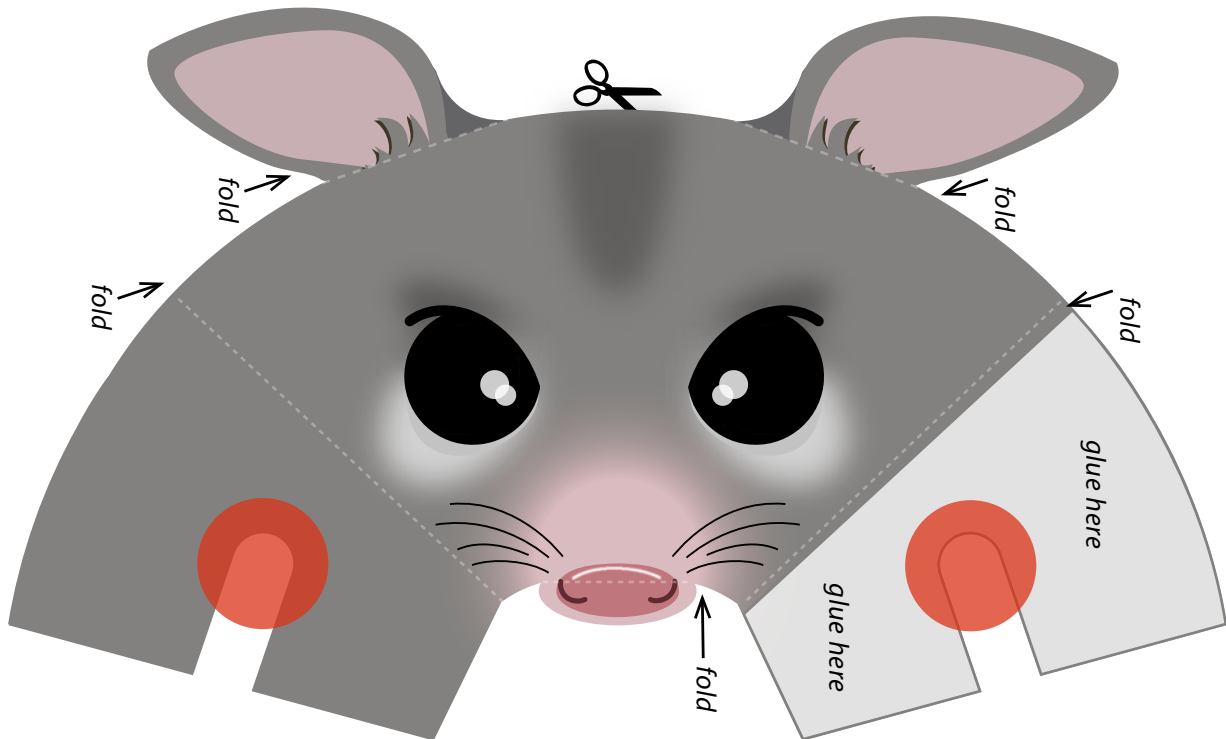
HOW TO MAKE A PITPAT FINGER PUPPET

You will need scissors and glue or sticky tape.

1. Cut around the outside.
2. Cut the red circles large enough to fit your child's finger.
3. Fold along the white dotted lines.
4. Secure the base with glue or sticky tape.
5. Help your child follow the words with the puppet where you see the Pitpat icon.
