

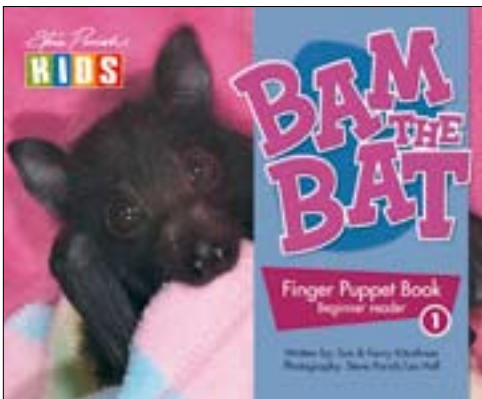


Finger Puppet Books

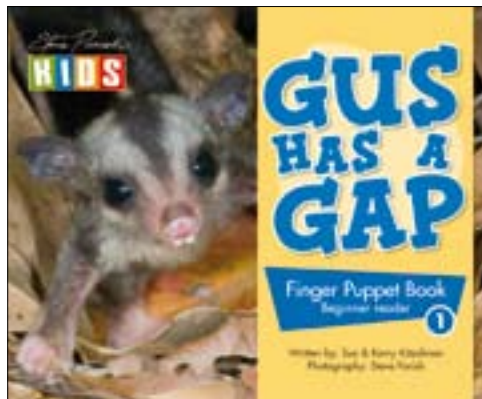
Finger Puppet Books are an exceptional resource for teaching reading skills by enlisting parental support at home.

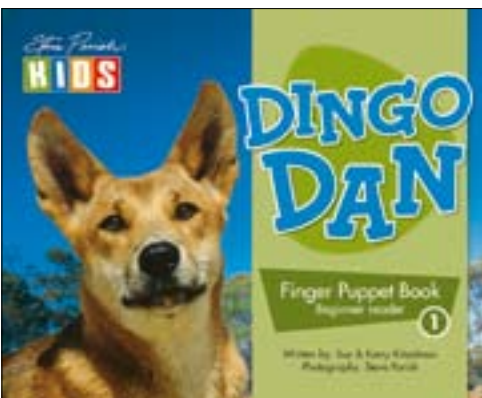

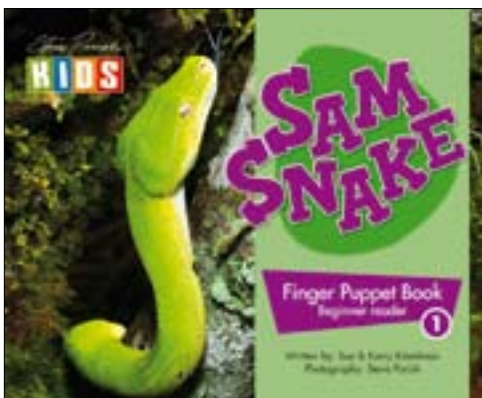

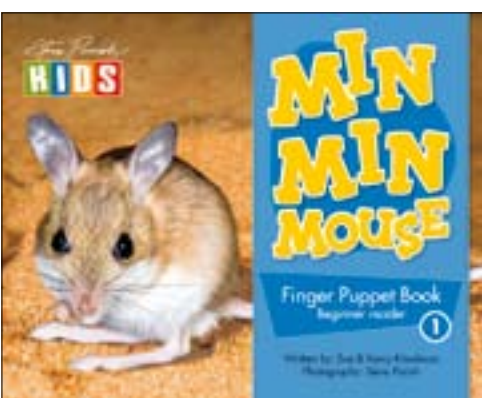
